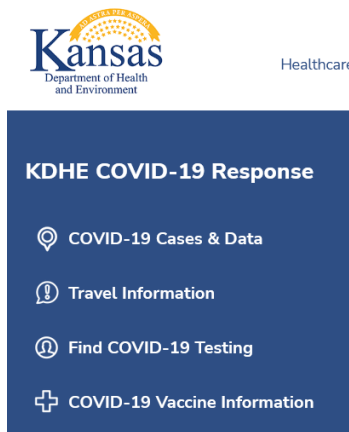


Instructions on How to Find the COVID-19 Numbers on the KDHE Website

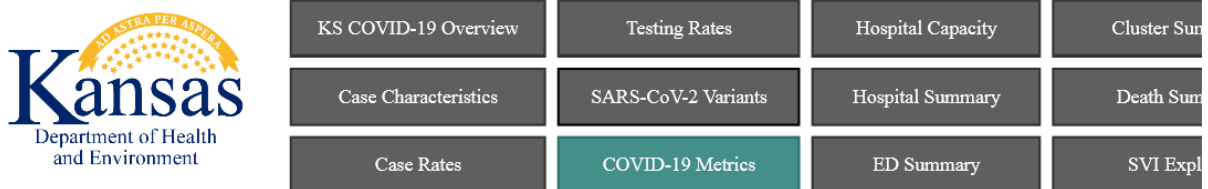
1. Go to: <https://www.coronavirus.kdheks.gov/>
2. Select: **COVID-19 Resource Center**



3. Select: **COVID-19 Cases & Data**



4. Scroll down to view: State Map of COVID-19 Cases
- Gives accumulative # of positive Cases per County
5. For additional weekly data per County
Select: **COVID-19 Metrics**



6. Select: **Weekly Percent Positive by County and Age Groups**



- Select: **The Drop down; Select a County or Counties** (Uncheck All, Check the box next to Pratt if you only want to see Pratt County data) Click outside of the drop down to apply selection.

Weekly Percent Positivity by County

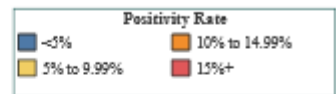
Select a County or Counties: Select Age Group(s):

Age Group/Week/Total PCR Tests/Negative PCR Tests/Positive PCR Tests/ % Positive

Hovering over the bottom dot gives you weekly totals.
Positive PCR Tests for the week = Active Cases for the week.

Current week data may not be complete.

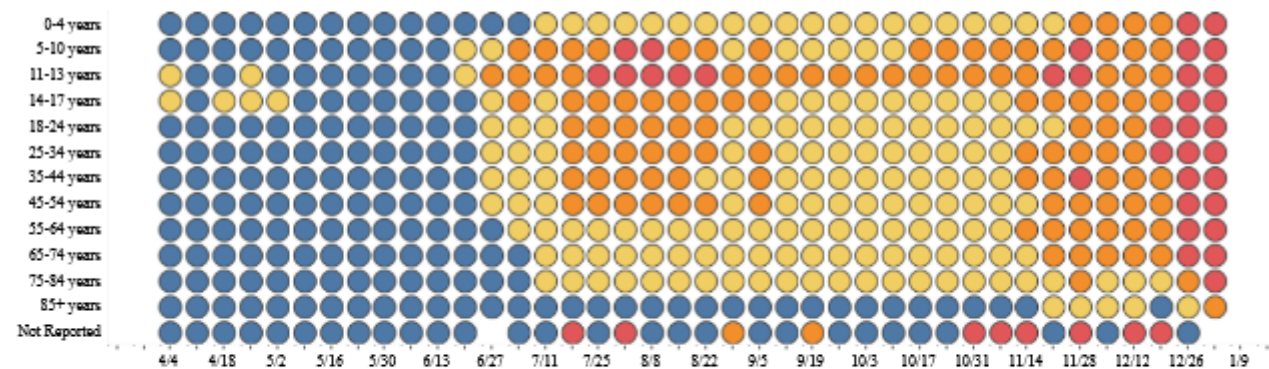


Weekly Percent Positivity

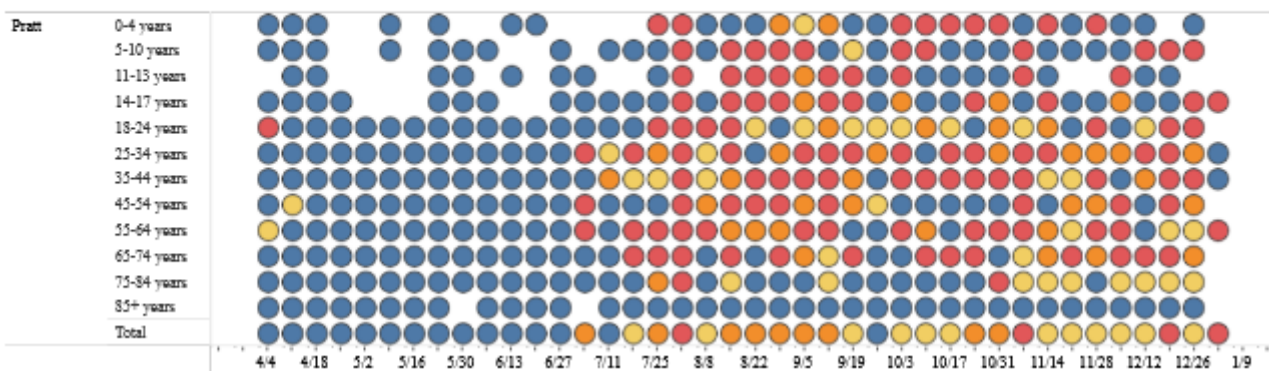
